Responsible and invested with a duty to conserve existing buildings, we think about adaptation and conservation before deconstruction or demolition. For new constructions, we think about materiality, adaptability, dismantling, etc...



→ Relocation and reuse of reclaimed wooden arches to create a recycling center. Conservation requires rigorous approaches, based on structural behavior analysis and detailed inspection of reused structures.



→ Fire safety is a crucial topic for the reuse of structures. Our complex numerical approaches allow to justify structures considered obsolete.

→ Each project requires an objective analysis of constraints and opportunities in order to make the optimal choice.
